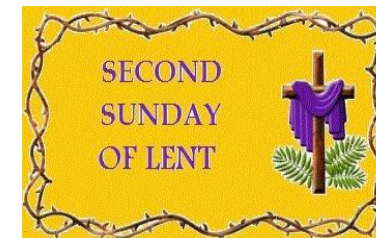

**PEACE AND PRAYER** During Lent there will be a series called 'Peace and Prayer'. 45 minutes of creative worship and prayer in the north transept at 4.00pm on Wednesdays. 4<sup>th</sup> March until 1<sup>st</sup> April inclusive.

**CORONAVIRUS** There is understandably concern from folk about the increasing spread of Coronavirus. After discussion with clergy colleagues and the Churchwardens I have decided that for the time being we will not shake hands at the **Peace** and only distribute the bread at **Holy Communion**. The Celebrant will receive wine on behalf of all of us. This is theologically sound as in receiving the wafer we are receiving the whole of Communion. Throughout the journey of faith there will be occasions when this is all that we can do. I believe that this is one of those occasions and we have a duty to protect the most vulnerable among us. We are reminded that when it comes to reception of Communion God honors our intentions as well as our actions. Let us continue to pray for those who have lost their lives, those who mourn them and those who are sick at this time.

Please remember to wash hands and use a hand sanitiser regularly.
