A heartfelt thank you for considering your giving to the ministry of St Martin's. Perhaps the following line sums up where we need to be: "Give to God what is right, not what is left"

There is no membership fee to belong to the Church, so each of us must decide for ourselves how much to give.

As Christians we can make that decision through prayer and understanding our special relationship.

Giving to your Church is part of Christian Stewardship which includes giving time, talent and money for the management of resources, to enable the mission and ministry of the Church within God's creation.

Each of us can afford to give away some of our money. It may be the widow's mite, or a millionaire's trust fund. St. Paul in his letter to the Corinthians said, "Every Sunday, each of you must put aside some money in proportion to what has been earned."

Many people try to give away one tenth of their take-home pay in accordance with the biblical tithe. The General Synod has asked all members of the Church of England to aim at giving a minimum of 5p in the £ (1/20th) of their disposable income "to and through the church". However, we would be grateful for any donation you are able to give.

Your generous giving allows us to continue to serve God through our church, to make Christ known in our village and to offer pastoral care to members of our community and beyond.
